
Dear Dr. Kanumury:

I met Diana when we joined the faculty at The Ohio State University Medical Center (OSUMC) in 2005. She performed a Feng Shui analysis of the building that the Center for Integrative Medicine was moving in to. The building's previous occupants had business and relationship issues, so OSUMC wanted to improve the energy. This was the first integrative center in Ohio, so there was great interest in its success.
